The SteemChurch is simply an online blockchain based community representing '*Family, Freedom and Faith.*'

No funds were ever raised, demanded, requested or accepted from SteemChurch members or otherwise in the creation and distribution of the Beatitude. The Beatitude is not an ICO and Beatitudes are freely granted.

To truly understand the **purpose** of the Beatitude blessing you must first turn to the **Holy Bible** for the '*Eight Beatitudes of Jesus*' (*Annexure 1*). Following this reading you should return to the beginning of the **New Testament** and read all. Finally, turn to the **Old Testament** and read all.

The **Beatitude Ascension** commenced on 30 May 2019. Prior to the ascension 144,000 HEARTs were issued – 12,000 to each of the Tribes of the Israelites. These original blessings will make their way into the world and to their rightful heirs over the years to come.
